
Dear Mr. Trenk:

The State Bar recently received a bar charge against you from Ms. Bentley. After our review of the charge, we have determined that no further investigation is warranted at this time. We therefore consider this file closed.

Ms. Bentley's charge alleged that you committed a criminal act in violation of ARS § 19-206(B) by signing a name other than your own to a recall petition. We have informed Ms. Bentley that allegations of criminal misconduct should be directed to the appropriate law enforcement agency rather than the State Bar of Arizona. However, should you be convicted of any crime arising out of this conduct, you are directed to notify the State Bar in writing so the matter may be reviewed at that time.

If you wish to receive a copy of the charge filed by Ms. Bentley please notify us at the number above and it will be provided. Pursuant to Rule 70(a)(4), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., the record of this charge will be public for six months from the date of this letter. This charge has no adverse impact on your standing with the State Bar. The record shows a consumer charge that was dismissed. Pursuant to Rule 71, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., the State Bar file may be expunged in three years.
